



Selection Process for 2019-2020 Cadre

Principles

The Cadre-A will be the group targeting high level performance and will have a personalized coaching by the Head Coach of the Swiss Team. The athletes belonging to the Cadre-A will have free access to the World Archery Excellence Centre and the Swiss Head coach.

Cadre-B will be regrouping all athletes with potential to become competitive athletes on the international scene. They will meet on a regular basis during training camps managed by the Head Coach of Swiss Team, in cooperation with their personal and/or regional coaches.

Rules

Minimas shall be shot at the distance corresponding to the athlete's category in 2019, in official competition shot under World Archery Rules. All scores shot since 15 March 2019 will be accepted.

If an athlete is taking part in different shoots at the same event, all score can be registered for minima.

All scores will have to be sent to the Sports Commission, before **28 August 2019**, all athletes fulfilling the score requirements will be invited to the validation weekend to be held in Tenero in September.

Athletes renewing their registration to the cadre, but missing minima scores will be given the opportunity to shoot one 72 arrow round on the Saturday of the training camp held in September.

The athlete, by entering in the cadre, accept to respect all the rules set in the document "9.1 Swiss Archery – National Team" which can be found on the Swiss Archery website

Minima

For 2019-2020 season, National Cadre will be divided into two blocks, with different objectives and programmes. The following scores will have to be shot twice. Cadre-A minima are in bold, Cadre-B minima are in italics:
